PAYMENT OF TOUR: Deposit of \$750 per person is due immediately to hold a place on the tour. All checks or money orders should be in U.S. dollars and made payable to Festival Tours International. Please mail your check along with your signed Booking Form and Booking Information & Conditions to Festival Tours International, 15332 Antioch Street #17, Pacific Palisades, CA 90272. Sorry, credit cards are not accepted.

Early Bird prices are valid until December 15, 2011. Reservations made after this date will be subject to a \$150 booking fee.

Balance for the tour is due no later than May 1, 2012. Balances paid after this date will be subject to a \$150 booking fee.

Prices are based on a minimum of 40 tour participants. In the unlikely event that the final number of sign ups are below 40, then a supplement will need to be charged.

Please note that the tour price is subject to changes in foreign currency. Therefore, we recommend that you pay for the trip in full now, as prices are not guaranteed until paid in full.

WIRE TRANSFERS: Electronic funds transfers must be made in U.S. dollars. Please contact Joey Thompson by email at merlingr@ix.netcom.com for Festival Tours International's banking details.

CANCELLATION POLICY: ALL CANCELLATIONS MUST BE RECEIVED IN WRITING BY THE DEADLINE.

90 days or more before departure, there will be a \$500 cancellation fee.

31 - 90 days before departure, 50% of the tour price is refundable.

30 days or less prior to departure, no refund will be available.

TRAVEL INSURANCE: We strongly advise you to protect yourself with Travel Insurance, available from any travel agency. Festival Tours International does not provide this service. Coverage available usually includes Trip Cancellation/ Interruption, Flight Insurance, and Accident Medical and Sickness Expense. See individual policy for details.

FLIGHTS/HOTELS: The tour officially begins at our hotel in Windsor on Sunday, August 5, 2012. The trip ends after breakfast in Banbury on Sunday, August 12 for the "England Only" tour, and in Edinburgh, August 19 for the "Full Tour". You are responsible for your international flight as well as transportation to the hotel in Windsor when you arrive. The most convenient and closest airport to Windsor is Heathrow. You are also responsible for return transport to the airport from Banbury if you're on the England Only trip or from Edinburgh City Centre to the airport or train station if you are on the Full Tour. We will be happy to advise you on the best way to do this. When booking your international flight, you should make sure that you arrive into Windsor no later than the morning of August 5, as our first welcoming event will start at 5:00 p.m. When flying from the USA, this generally means that you will depart the day before (August 4). We cannot be responsible if you choose a flight that arrives late. For this reason, as well as to have time to fully enjoy Windsor, we recommend you arrive a day early on Saturday, August 4. This means you would likely depart the USA on August 3. Unless you have opted for extra nights in Edinburgh, you should book a flight or train from Edinburgh on Sunday, August 19 to coordinate with your transatlantic flight.

All of our handpicked hotels include breakfast. Occasionally there might be an additional charge at the hotel for the option of a (hot) Full English Breakfast.

In Banchory, August 15 & 16, we will use the Banchory Lodge Hotel as our base for dinner and a ceilidh. Because of the limited number of rooms at this hotel, we will also be using nearby B & B or hotel accommodations. Transportation will be provided to and from the Banchory Lodge.

SINGLE ROOM: If you would like to have a single room, there will be a supplement of \$800 for the England Only trip, and \$1400 for the Full Tour. Please note that a single room may not be available at some hotels.

SHARING A ROOM: If you wish to share a twin room and are traveling by yourself, we will be happy to try to arrange a roommate for you which is usually not a problem. If we are not able to find someone suitable for you, you will have to pay the single supplement. However, the earlier you sign up, the better chance you have for us to match you up.

UPGRADES: There are a limited number of upgraded rooms at two of our hotels - the Whately Hall in Banbury on the England Only portion of our tour and Lumley Castle in Northumberland on the Full Tour. Upgrades are subject to availability, and a refund will be made if an upgraded room is not available.

- **WHATELY HALL** - These rooms are slightly larger, generally with a sitting area, and include bathrobes and slippers. Upgrade charge: \$150 per person for the 6 nights. If you are sharing a room, this upgrade charge must be paid by both people in the room.
- **LUMLEY CASTLE** - All rooms at Lumley Castle are individually furnished, but a limited number of rooms are located in the castle itself with special "features" such as secret bathrooms and unusual antiques. These "Feature Rooms" are only available as a double bedded room, no twins. Upgrade charge: \$60 per person for the one night.

EXTENDING YOUR TRIP: If you'd like to arrive in Windsor earlier than August 5 or stay on in Edinburgh after the tour (both recommended!), we may be able to reserve additional nights for you at the group hotel. You will pay for these extra nights in pounds sterling once you arrive in Windsor. Please remember that these are confirmed reservations made on your behalf. Because there are special events in both of these cities (the Olympics in Windsor and the Edinburgh Festival in Scotland) rooms are at a premium and we are required to prepay for the rooms now on your behalf. Therefore, no cancellations are allowed.

NOT INCLUDED IN TOUR PRICE: International flights, airport transfers upon arrival, flight or transport from Banbury or Edinburgh at end of tour, driver and hotel tips, meals other than those listed, drinks at group meals, optional concerts and beer for the band!

RESPONSIBILITY: The Agent, Tour Operators and their representatives give notice that all tickets and coupons are issued by them and all arrangements for transportation and hotel accommodations, etc. are made by them upon the express condition that they shall not be liable for any injury, loss, damage, accident, delay or irregularity that may be occasioned either by reason of defect in any vehicle or through the acts or default of any company or persons engaged in conveying the passenger.
